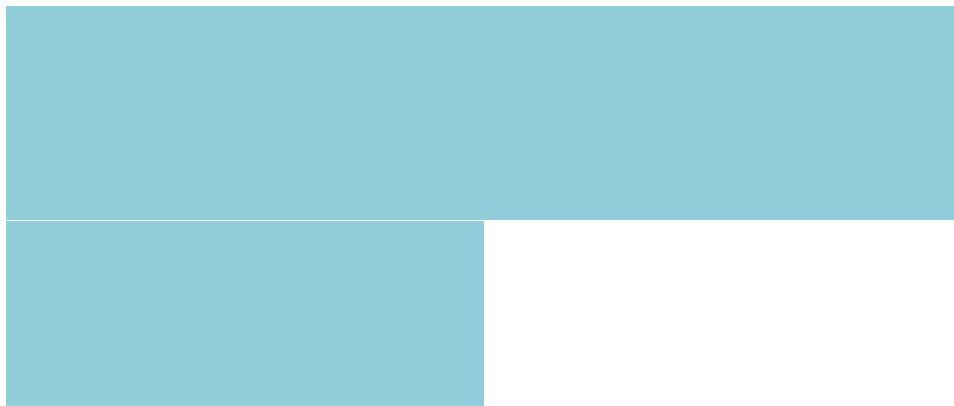

Your Right of Access

You have a right to access to your data and to certain information about the processing of that personal data. This information must usually be provided to you free of charge within a month of receiving your request.

Exceptions to this are:

- ◁ Examination scripts which are specifically exempt from the data subject access rights under the General Data Protection Regulation. In general, students are entitled to know their examination marks but are not entitled to see their examination scripts. However, students are entitled to see associated assessment comments and minutes of any examination appeals panels, which are not exempt from
